

Awana at Home Registration Options

We are so excited to announce that Awana is just around the corner! We have created some exciting options that will allow every family to take part in this year's Awana at Home! Awana will stream online weekly on **Wednesday evenings** returning on **January 13th**. You can stream on Youtube, Facebook, or our HG Website. **Registration for Awana at Home is now open!**

Please take a moment to read about your options before registering:

In-Person Coaching: If you register for In-Person Coaching, please take note of the following:

- In- Person Coaching will take place at our Mallard Creek location every Tuesday evening from 5:30pm-6:30pm returning on January 19th. You may arrive anytime between **5:30-6:30pm**.
- This coaching option will be in a drive thru model. When you arrive, please drive underneath the portico at the front doors. A staff member will be there to assist your child(ren) inside and direct you on where to park while you wait.
- Our coaches are required to wear a mask and our set-up follows social distancing guidelines. We are asking that children wear a mask upon entering the lobby, but children will be able to take their mask off when they are sitting down to say their verses. Please make this decision based off of your family's comfort. See our [Wellness Policy](#) for more health guidelines.
- Meeting with a coach is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Your wait time will depend on how many people arrive at the same time as you. Therefore, we cannot guarantee that you will not have to wait in your car first. We will try to make the process as fast and safe as possible.
- Once your child is finished meeting with their coach, they will be escorted by a staff member to your car.

Phone Call Coaching: If you register for Phone Call Coaching, please take note of the following:

- You will receive a phone call from a coach every Tuesday night between 5-7pm beginning on January 19th.
- You are required to put the phone call on speaker mode.
- A parent/guardian must be on the phone call with your child.
- Please make sure your child and their handbook are ready for their phone call by 5pm.
- A parent/guardian is committing to sign-off on their child(s) verse each week according to the [handbook standards](#).

- You will have a chance to pick up your child's jewels/patches at a later date. More information on this pickup will be given in the following weeks.

Parent Coaching: If you register for Parent Coaching, please take note of the following:

- A parent/guardian is committing to sign-off on their child(s) verse each week according to the [handbook standards](#).
- You will have a chance to pick up your child's jewels/patches at a later date. More information on this pickup will be given in the following weeks.

Changing Your Coaching Option: If you decide the coaching option your family is registered for no longer serves your family well, please feel free to contact our Children's Ministry office and we will assist you in switching to the next best option for your family.

If your child requires a new handbook or uniform, you may purchase those at the Awana Store. Details on the Awana Store dates and times will be provided after you register your child.
