PHILIP AND THE ETHIOPIAN

STARTING POINT

✈️ Share about a time that you made a new friend.

Parent Helps (PH): Starting Point is designed as a conversation starter. This section allows you to introduce big concepts in simple questions.

TRUE NORTH

Acts 8:26-40 (Further Study: Isaiah 53:1-8)

PH: The True North section is designed to point us to God's Word. This section allows you to disciple your family by opening the Bible together.

TRAIL MARKERS

PH: Trail Markers are designed to get your family talking about important issues. This section allows you to see what your family thinks and believes about who God is.

1. Who was Isaiah writing about?

PH: The prophet Isaiah was talking about Jesus, who was despised and rejected for us. Sometimes we feel rejected by friends or even by family, but God accepts us through Jesus.

2. Is the Bible always easy to understand?

PH: No, sometimes the Bible is very difficult to understand. Adults and kids all struggle to understand what some things in the Bible mean. However, as we continue to read and learn, it gets easier. If we have questions, we can always look for help.

3. Which Bible story would you use to share the gospel with someone?

PH: Take some time to think together about how you could use your Bible to help share the gospel with friends, family, or even with someone that you just met!

END POINT

PH: The Ethiopian official knew what the Old Testament prophets said, but he did not understand that they spoke about Jesus. The Holy Spirit led Philip to help the official understand the good news about Jesus: Jesus died on the cross for our sins and was raised from the dead, just like the Old Testament prophets said.
