## COVID SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL INVOLVED WITH HG SPORTS:

- Stay home if you are not feeling well.
- Upon entering the complex everyone is strongly encouraged to wear a face mask and continue wearing a face mask when 6' of social distancing is not possible.
- Stay 6' apart from anyone in the complex when possible.
- Coaches, officials, and staff are <u>required</u> to wear a face mask.
- Everyone entering the complex is encouraged to wash/sanitize hands prior to and following practices/games. Hand sanitizer will be available at the complex.
- Parents/spectators are asked to bring their own chairs and social distance a minimum of 6' from other families.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to limit the number of family members at team practices.
- Practice/game times will be staggered to limit the number of person-to-person contact when entering/exiting the complex.
- Players will be spaced out using dugouts and tent areas to extend dugout space.
- All equipment and benches will be disinfected after each use.
- Number of participants limited on each team.
- Child's temperature must be taken prior to arriving for practice/game. If child presents a fever of 100.4 or higher or is not feeling well, please stay home.
- Participants are asked to bring a chair for use in the dugout.
- Participants are required to wear a face mask until they are engaged in physical activity.
- No snacks offered to team members. Participants must bring a personal water bottle with name clearly marked. No sharing allowed.
- No sharing helmets, towels or any items that come in contact with the face.
- If your child or any member of your household has been placed on quarantine, or is experiencing any COVID related symptoms such as, but not limited to: fever, chills, cough, headache, loss of taste or smell and/or shortness of breath, please do not attend practices/games.
- If your child, or someone in the same household as your child, contracts COVID-19, it is your responsibility to inform the HG Sports Office immediately (704-531-3482).

## **REFUND POLICY**

Program cancellation or postponement are possibilities if it is deemed in the best interest of public safety.

- Full refund offered if child withdraws during registration period.\*
- 50% refund offered if child withdraws after the registration period has ended.\*
- No refund offered after the season begins.

\*Refund offered will not include the additional \$10 fee if the child registered after the date of the fee increase.

(Considering the ongoing uncertainty with the COVID-19 pandemic, including the possibility that games or the season could be cancelled suddenly, **once the season begins no refunds will be issued** due to the costs already accrued by Hickory Grove Baptist Church.)
