



A PARENT'S GUIDE TO WORSHIP CARE

AT HICKORY GROVE DURING COVID-19

STEP 1

RSVP online for childcare at HickoryGrove.org/Regathering.

SUNDAYS 10-11 AM: Your child must be registered for Worship Care weekly.

RSVP each week starting at noon on Tuesday and ending at noon on Friday. The link to register will be available on our HG website Tuesday morning for the following Sunday.

STEP 2

All children who are registered for Worship Care must have their temperature checked and answer a short health screening questionnaire at the entrance. If your child has a temperature of 100.4° or greater, he/she will not be permitted to a classroom.

PLEASE STAY HOME IF *your child has had a fever, sore throat, coughing, diarrhea, or vomiting in the 48 hours before childcare, or if your child has had close contact (within six feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19 in the last 14 days.*

STEP 3

Check-in your child at the health screening table outside of the HG Kids ministry area. Once approved, a ministry volunteer will complete your child's check-in process at a kiosk. Once you receive your security tags, one parent/guardian will be allowed to walk your child to their classroom.

STEP 4

After the worship gathering, children will be picked up at their classroom. Please present your security tag to the teacher and your child will be brought to you.

STEP 5

Visit HickoryGrove.org/Regathering or check your email to RSVP for next week.

Extra Guidelines, Precautions, & Things to Expect

- All staff and volunteers will wear masks. Masks are encouraged for children ages 5 and older.
- The Preschool entrance and the Education Lobby will be the only two entry points for Worship Care.
- Classroom capacity will be limited per CDC guidelines.
- Classrooms will be sanitized after each use.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the church.
- If you arrive more than 15 minutes after the worship gathering starts, we may give your reservation away.
- No diaper bags, car seats, or strollers will be allowed in the classroom or hallway. Bags will be available for parents to put items in.
- No snacks or food will be served or permitted; however, you may send bottles with infants.
- Sippy cups/water bottles are permitted, but they must be clearly labeled with the child's first and last name and contain only water.
- All preschoolers will remain in their class for the duration of the gathering.
