 - 1. Warn the Irresponsible

4. Be Patient with Everyone

5. Refuse to Retaliate

1 Thess. 5:15 See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.

2. The Importance of Personal Devotion (5:16-22)

A. Joyful in Outlook

1 Thess. 5:16 Rejoice always,

B. Persistent in Prayer

1 Thess. 5:17 pray without ceasing,

C. Grateful in Attitude

1 Thess. 5:18 give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

D. Sensitive to the Spirit

1 Thess. 5:19 Do not quench the Spirit.

E. Obedient to Scripture

1 Thess. 5:20 Do not despise prophecies,

F. Committed to Discernment

1 Thess. 5:21-22 but test everything; hold fast what is good. Abstain from every form of evil.
