1 Corinthians 1:2 To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours:

Saints

- 1. Saints are ordinary believers
- 2. Saints are set apart
- 3. Saints are formed by grace
- 4. Saints are striving to act like saints

Sinners

- 1. Sin is minimized by the world
- 2. Sin is Serious
- 3. Sin is infectious

4. Sin is against God

Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
