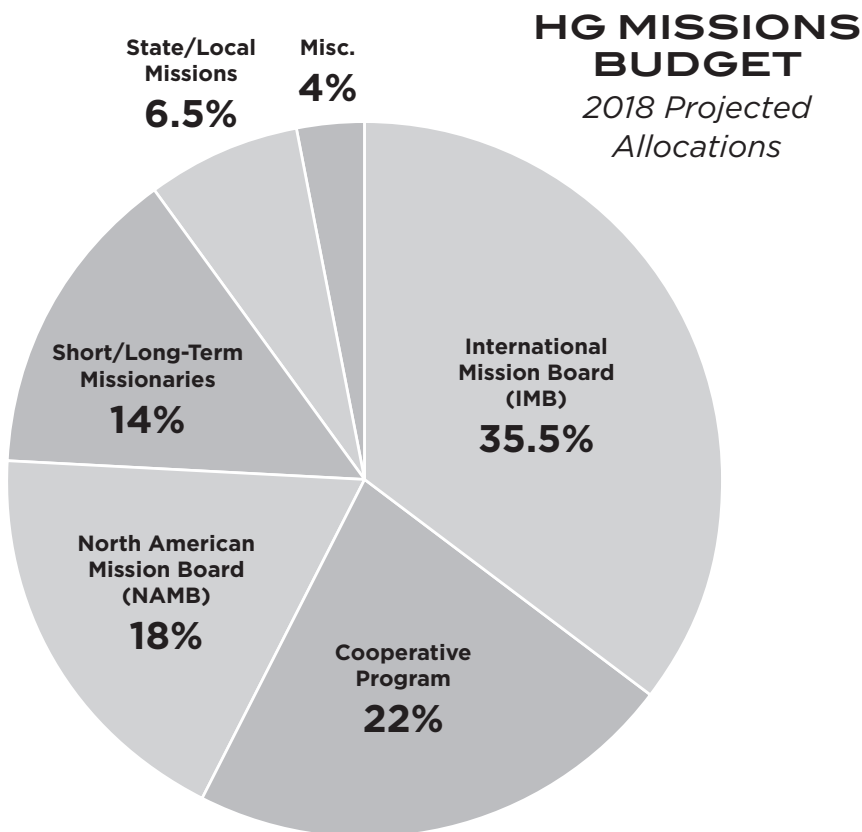


COOPERATIVE PROGRAM
