What is Discipleship?

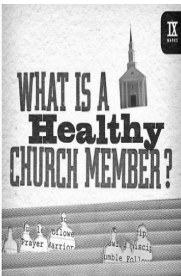
Believers in Jesus have the great privilege to bear the fruit of His resurrected life. The process of becoming more like Christ is called **sanctification** and the **primary vehicle of sanctification is discipleship**. It is the non-negotiable responsibility of Christians to pursue spiritual growth and produce third-generation disciples. Unlike conversion, discipleship is a gradual process, not an isolated event.

Discipleship helps believers follow the Son of God in obedience and faith. **Discipleship** accomplishes the mission of God as we teach others to observe all that Jesus has commanded us. **Discipleship** requires the Spirit of God to convict believers and motivate them toward holiness. **Discipleship** involves the Word of God to reveal, clarify, and charge believers toward Christ-likeness. Finally, **Discipleship** equips the people of God to encourage each other, admonish one another, and exemplify a life worth emulating.

Why Discipleship matters:

Discipleship and spiritual growth should be normal in the life of a believer. The New Testament teaches that the church should grow up in every way so that it builds itself up in love. **This growth is a powerful testimony to the transformative power of the Gospel**. As a body of believers, everything we do, from the worship service to the Sunday school hour to community groups, is designed to foster discipleship so we might honor God and showcase the beauty of His Gospel to others.

The Book of Romans is **one of the most influential books** ever written. Martin Luther called it the absolute epitome of the Gospel. The great theologian, Augustine of Hippo, was dramatically converted by taking it up and reading its pages!

Paul's letter to the Romans was written to **clarify the Gospel, encourage believers, and motivate evangelism**. It was written to a church trying to live out its Christian faith with a distinctly Christian worldview. Similar to us, they were diverse in their backgrounds and experiences, yet, just like us, they were unified in their belief in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. **Romans** is an incredible letter inspired by God and created to lead us to worship the Lord Jesus Christ and to live out the implications of the Gospel **together as a church**.

Beginning in February, Hickory Grove begins a new sermon series in the Book of Romans. Join us each Sunday as Pastor Clint Pressley goes verse-by-verse and teaches Romans.

We have **scripture journals available** for purchase in our resource center to help you study, memorize, and meditate on Romans throughout this series.
