

ROMANS SERMON SERIES



Today, Hickory Grove begins a new sermon series. Join Pastor Clint Pressley as he goes verse-by-verse and teaches through the book of Romans.

Romans is one of the most influential books ever written. Martin Luther called it the absolute **epitome of the Gospel.** The great theologian Augustine of Hippo was dramatically converted by taking it up and reading its pages! Paul's letter to the Romans was written to **clarify the Gospel, encourage believers, and motivate evangelism.** It was written to a church trying to live out its Christian faith with a distinctly Christian worldview. Similar to us, they were diverse in their backgrounds and experiences, yet, just like us, they were **unified in their belief** in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Romans is an incredible letter inspired by God and created to lead us to worship the Lord Jesus Christ and to live out the implications of the Gospel together as a church.
