CALL TO WORSHIP

CORPORATE CONFESSION

In light of God's holiness, wrath, and grace, we acknowledge that we have all sinned against God and are in need of His sanctifying grace. This confession occurs in the context of a covenant relationship made possible through the perfect life, substitutionary death, and victorious resurrection of Jesus. As Christians, our confession is not so that God should forgive us, but because, through Christ, He has already forgiven us.

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

Paul's letter to the Romans was written to **clarify the Gospel, encourage believers, and motivate evangelism**. Similar to us, they were diverse in their backgrounds and experiences, yet, just like us, they were **unified in their belief** in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Romans is an incredible letter inspired by God and created to lead us to worship the Lord Jesus Christ and to live out the implications of the Gospel together as a church.

We have **Scripture Journals** available for purchase in our Resource Center to help you study, memorize, and meditate on Romans throughout this series.

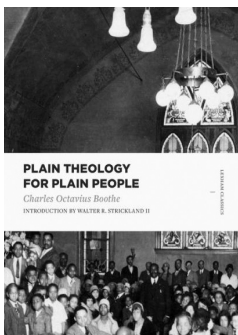
SCRIPTURE MEMORY

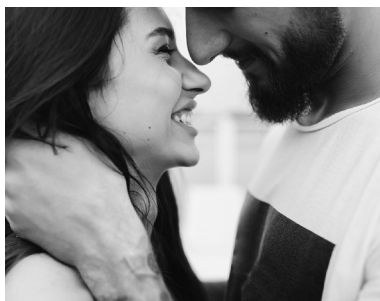
