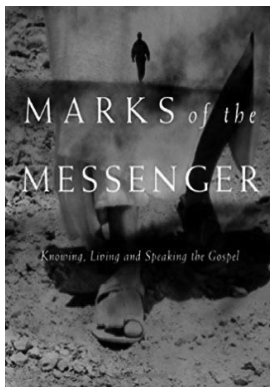
who's your ① ONE?
