# CALL TO WORSHIP

# What is a Parent/ Child Dedication?

The Scripture is clear that God has called parents to be the primary disciple-makers in the lives of their children. One way we take this calling seriously at Hickory Grove is through our Parent/Child Dedication ceremony, during which we formally recognize, in a corporate worship service, parents who have had a new child enter the family, and we charge them to Pass the Torch in their own home.

This time is designed for parents to publicly commit before the church that they will, with God's help, be the primary disciple-maker(s) in the life of their child. It is also designed for parents to acknowledge God's sovereignty over their child, recognizing that "children are a heritage from the Lord" (Psalm 127:3), and that this child has been entrusted to them by God.

It is imperative for the church to commit corporately to partner with these families by coming alongside them as they seek to raise their children to love Christ above all things.

# How can the church partner with families?

While Scripture has called parents to be the primary disciple-makers in the lives of their children, the local church should support these parents in a partnership. As a member of the body of Christ, here are some ways you can come alongside these families in partnership:

**1. PRAY.** Pray that God will help parents faithfully shepherd their children during their most formative years. Pray also for our children, that they will be protected from the evil one (John 17:15) and that they will one day put their faith in Jesus Christ.

2. GET INVOLVED. Join Hickory Grove's efforts in "passing the torch" to the next generation by getting involved in the HG Kids or HG Students Ministries. These ministries partner with families, and the opportunities for discipleship are endless, so join the team!


# SCRIPTURE MEMORY




Gospel Fluency: Speaking the Truths of Jesus into the Everyday Stuff of Life **by Jeff Vanderstelt**


