- Pray that God will equip parents to cultivate their discipling relationship with their kids when they return from camp.

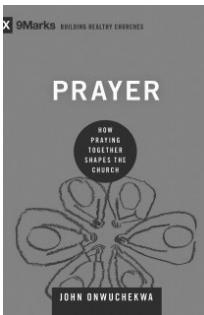
SCRIPTURE MEMORY
