Sunday Mornings

Childcare (Infant-1 year olds) - Opportunities to invest in the lives of young preschoolers during the Wednesday night ministry activities.

Welcome Team - Opportunities to serve guests and members, including door greeters and ushers.

Other

Sports League Coach - Opportunity to invest in others through coaching youth basketball/cheer, youth baseball/softball, and youth soccer.

Food Services - Opportunity to serve meals, assist with kitchen/meal cleanup or serve as a cashier on Wednesdays or during special events.
