HGCS 25TH ANNIVERSARY

n August 21, 1995, Hickory Grove Baptist Christian School opened to begin what has been 25 years of successful Christian education with seven elementary classes and graduated its first seniors in 2004. Since that day, what is now known as Hickory Grove Christian School (HGCS) has blossomed into a TK-12th-grade school supported by two Early Education Centers (EEC) at both the Harris and Mallard Creek campuses.

Over the last several years, the school has begun a **Spanish Immersion Program** in K-3rd grade and developed a fully functional **aquaponics garden** that consistently grows fresh vegetables for the church food pantry which is used by Second Harvest Food Bank for the community. The school is also blessed with successful arts and athletic programs.

Students who matriculate out of the lower grades enter into a rigorous college-prep high school anchored by a biblical worldview and Gospel-centered education.

HGCS boasts 16 Advanced Placement (AP) classes with high passing rates in all subjects as well as being the only evangelical, private Christian school in North Carolina that can graduate seniors with the prestigious AP Capstone Diploma.

The extremely successful high school graduates seniors who receive millions of scholarship dollars each year and has seen those students accepted at 175 colleges and universities and all military service academies.



The school boasts a decorated faculty with a large percentage who have received graduate degrees and many more currently pursuing graduate degrees in their fields. Professional development is often led not only by Hickory Grove Baptist Church but also by some of the great thinkers and authors in today's society. This illustrious list includes Dr. Albert Mohler, Jared Wilson, Dr. Mark Dever, and Dr. Chuck Lawless. Further, for the 2019–20 school year, HGCS has been accepted as an Educational Affiliate of the Colson Center Fellows Program which will help to continue to deliver a truly biblical worldview curriculum. While HGCS is recognized as an excellent choice for academic preparation, the school prides itself on being deeply convictional in a world that often compromises values and Christian beliefs. HGCS has stood by its Gospel-centered, evangelical and missional pursuits with the faculty that we hire and the students we teach. We hope you will celebrate 25 years of Christian education with us this year! ■
