CALL TO WORSHIP

Who are the unreached?

A group of people is *unreached* when less than 2 percent of its population is evangelical Christian. A people group is *unengaged* when no evangelical church-planting strategy is being implemented among them.



There are currently **3,176** unengaged and unreached people groups in the world.



What is the International Mission Board (IMB)?

IMB is the international mission-sending board of the Southern Baptist Convention. The board currently has more than 3,700 missionaries working with 847 people groups, many of which have never heard the name of Jesus. Hickory Grove supports the IMB through your faithful +1 giving.
