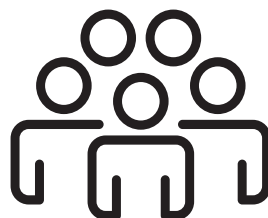

Who are the unreached?

A group of people is **unreached** when less than 2 percent of its population is evangelical Christian.

A people group is **unengaged** when no evangelical church-planting strategy is being implemented among them.



There are currently **3,176** unengaged and unreached people groups in the world.

IMB is the international mission-sending board of the Southern Baptist Convention. The board currently has more than 3,700 missionaries working with 847 people groups, many of which have never heard the name of Jesus. 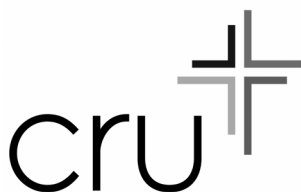
