AT HOME

As Christians, our homes are often the front door to the Gospel for the neighbors living around us. Pray the Lord will **use your home as an open door to the Gospel** in your neighborhood.

Do It Right - Give out good candy.

Be Engaging and Present - Sit out on the porch and be friendly.

Go the Extra Mile - Have a fire pit, s'mores, and great decorations.

Think of Adults - Have coffee, hot chocolate, desserts for adults.

GO OUT

Some of your neighbors may not come to your house, but you can have an inroad for the gospel with them by going out. Pray you will **engage with many of your neighbors** who would normally not be open to talk.

Walk Your Neighborhood - Take your kids trick-or-treating and visit every house.

Invite Others to Join - Go trick-or-treating with neighbors.

JOIN OTHERS

Join with others who have made plans to gather for the evening. Pray the Lord will **open doors for the Gospel** with people at your job, school, and neighborhood.

Join Others Trick-or-Treating - Be a part of others reaching their neighbors.

Join Others Who are Gathering - Look for groups among work, school, and friend circles.

CONVERSATION TIPS


There is a constant struggle for believers to want to find a way to get the whole Gospel out in one conversation. Think of this initial meeting as just a first step. If you are not able to have in-depth spiritual conversations, that is okay. The hope is that this encounter is just the beginning to more fruitful, Gospel conversations.

- 1. Pray and ask the Lord for opportunities.
- 2. Pay attention for open doors.
- 3. Learn people's stories.
- 4. Be friendly and encouraging.
- 5. Take notes as you meet neighbors to remember names and other details.
- 6. Be patient and look to make friendships and not just converts.
- 7. Be bold about your faith.



Imagine if every one at Hickory Grove could answer that question with the name of a person who is lost—a person for whom they're praying and with whom seeking to share the Gospel. We believe God's people don't merely need another method for evangelism.
