# DEACON ORDINATION: A GUIDE FOR THE CHURCH

---

## What is a deacon?

The word “deacon” is derived from the Greek word *diakonos*, which means “servant.” The New Testament mentions this term frequently, though perhaps its clearest usage can be found in Acts 6, where it appears the first deacons were appointed in the church at Jerusalem. This passage makes clear that the office of deacon was established to serve the church’s physical needs so that those who hold the office of pastor might focus on meeting the spiritual needs of the church through the ministry of the Word. **Thus, a deacon is one set apart to lead in serving and ministering to the needs of the local church.**

## What is ordination?

When members of the church are nominated by the congregation to the office of deacon and are found to meet the qualifications as outlined in the Scripture, the church elects them to serve and publicly recognizes them in a special service, whereby they are **“ordained” or are officially appointed and set apart as ones who are called of God and qualified for the deacon ministry.** Following the precedent set by the apostles in Acts 6:6, the pastor and other ordained men will lay their hands upon these men and pray for them. The ordination service is very special and helpful, not only for the ones being ordained but also for the congregation as a whole, as they get to celebrate God’s provision of faithful, servant leadership.




