

Daniel Ritchie was born without arms and spent the majority of his life being told that he was a hopeless mistake and woefully insufficient to lead a full life. But, God used a preacher to share with Daniel just how much God loved him. The preacher explained that he was not a mistake, but rather "fearfully and wonderfully made"

(Psalm 139) and it was there, at the age of 15, that Daniel accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior. He now spends his time traveling, preaching and speaking at churches, conferences and youth events in the United States and abroad.
